What Will I Experience?

Mount of Olives

Located on the eastern slopes of the Jerusalem mountains, near the Temple Mount and the City of David, this peak is named after the olive trees that covered its grounds in biblical times. Today, camels, monasteries, and ancient tombstones dot these scenic slopes.

Old City Christian Quarter

Take in the incredible view of the Wailing Wall on your way to the Christian Quarter. Visit the Pools of Bethesda and walk on along the Via Dolorosa, following the 14 Stations of the Cross from Pilate's Judgement Hall to the empty tomb in the Church of the Holy Sepulchre.

Bethlehem & The Tomb of Rachel

On your way to the Church of the Nativity, drive through what is known as one of the holiest sites in the Jewish religion and a stop for many on pilgrimage to the Holy Land.

Church of the Nativity

It is at the Church of the Nativity in Bethlehem where we will learn about the birth of Jesus at his actual location of birth. It is one of the world's oldest churches and houses the Grotto of the Nativity, the place where the birth took place.
